

October 25. 2015 Monsignor attended the International Priest Conference in Mexico. There he gave

his talks and workshops. He joined other priests and prayer warriors in a vigil at a hospital in Mexico City, where they perform free abortions. There are usually lines around the hospital and abortions are performed from 4:00 am-10:00 am in the mornings.

"Our goal, our purpose, is not only to save the physical life of the child. What we aim for ultimate-Iv is the conversion of hearts and the salvation of souls," Msgr. Reilly said. "We seek to join the Blessed Mother and St. John at the foot of the cross. the modern-day Calvary at the abortion mills, where the image of Christ among us today is being crucified. Even if we don't succeed in changing a woman's mind and saving her baby, at least we are there to pray and to express our love for the baby before he is destroyed ..."
