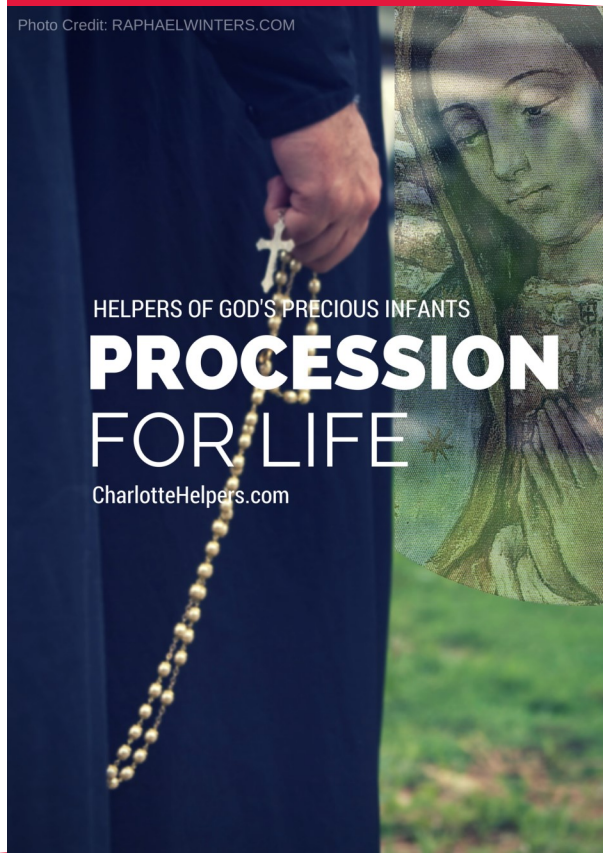
Priest: Let us pray that the doctors and nurses who use their skill to kill instead of heal, will repent and return to the service of the sick.
